MISSION

Medina Cares provides temporary financial assistance to Medina County residents 19-59 years old who are experiencing a medical crisis.



WAYS WE HELP

For qualified clients, we provide temporary financial support to pay for typical monthly expenses, such as:

- Rent
- Utility Bills
- Transportation
- Medication
- Groceries
- Medical Bills

To be considered for assistance, a client must meet some specific criteria:

- Be a resident of Medina County.
- The person has experienced a qualifying medical crisis in the past 0-9 months.
- The person has accounts that are otherwise in good standing.
- The person is employed or has an income.
- The person has not received financial assistance from Medina Cares in the past 12 months.

To assess if we can help, clients need to provide a full name, return contact number, needs, and description of the medical crisis/condition. Each case is reviewed by our Board of Directors to ensure assistance is given to qualifying individuals.

OUR REACH

Medina Cares only assists residents of Medina County, ages 19-59, who are experiencing a medical crisis.

We typically help 20-30 people in Medina County each year. Our goal is to double our reach by 2022.

TELL A FRIEND

This year we need your help! We've found that most of our clients have never needed to ask for financial assistance before. We know that there are people out there who need our support but don't know that we exist or where to turn.
